Beginning nearest the chancel and reading from right to left, we have first Mother Eve holding the infant Abel. Her companion is Sarah, "Mother of Kings and Nations", with her young son Isaac.

In the next pair Hagar, shielding Ishmael, is represented after being cast out. Rebecca holds the symbolic pitcher of water, while the young Jacob looks up to her.

In the next pair Rachel looks after Joseph who holds a toy suggesting the crown of Egypt where his influence is destined to be felt so tremendously. The young Obed stands beside Ruth, with the symbolic sheaf of wheat nearby.

Hannah bears the infant Samuel in her arms and holds the small coat which she brought to him at the temple each year. The last panel is devoted to the young Solomon and Bathsheba who holds the symbolic ewe lamb.

We feel that this group of windows has worked out beautifully, with pleasant variety and contrast of color and at the same time an over-all harmony which will unite all to excellent purpose. We are eager to develop them in the actual glass.
