General Information The Resurrection.

The three-panel window in the Family Transept is devoted to the Resurrection, with Our Lord bearing the cruciform banner of victory coming from the dark tomb above the sleeping guards, while John and Peter are represented at the left, and the three women at the right.

Above are symbols of the Resurrection, the phoenix rising from the flames, and the peacock; while members of the Angelic Choir kneel in adoration below.
