General Information There are 20 windows in banks of 5 on four sides of this octagonal church.

To have the maximum of light. Windows to be kept very simple, perhaps with four dominant figures in the central panel of each group. Should keep at least the lower part obscure enough so that things cannot be seen in or out.

We are to provide protection glass. Windows to be set in Hope frames. The following are Father Hennessey's ideas for subject. The entire theme is to be devoted to the Blessed Sacrament.

- 1. The Last Supper (which is the origin of the Blessed Sacrament.)
- 2. Mass at Church: (Blessed Sacrament in contemporary times, produced at Communion)
- 3. Holy Communion at Church: First Communion? with small children?
