General Information Have just a simple musical angel on a simple field - and perhaps a simple suggestion of canopy.
They are going to put in new temporary glass all through the church, - leaded opalescent. It is going to be rather light and not too yellow.
The one aisle window that is in is by Miss Pitassi. There is a little window that is also in - very much the same stype as the chancel window, probably made by Heaton, Butler and Bayne, and represents Christ Blessing Little Children.

The north window, near the organ, continues the suggestion of glory introduced in your great chancel window, with a choir of the Angelic Choir bearing a musical instrument, and a suggested text from the Psalter: "O come, let us sing unto the Lord."
