To be as simple and reasonable as possible.
In the doorlights that receive light - South, we are to have symbols
of Saint Francis Xavier and Saint Anthony, with the names.

In the other two, have The Little Flower and Saint John Evangelist. These
will have to be in very light color, and we have assured the pastor that
they certainly will not look like much, except as one enters from the
sacristy and sees them across in the light of the opposite doors.

All Phillips sizes are full.

We have also made a sketch for the two south doorlights, designing them in the symbols of Saint Francis Xavier, - a pilgrim's staff, and scroll inscribed: "In te Domine speravi" - the dying words of Saint Francis Xavier; and the tau cross and bell for Saint Anthony. With your approval of these, we will design the opposite pair of doorlights with the symbols of Saint Theresa and Saint John the Evangelist in a similar manner. As we said, these receive such poor light that their effectiveness will be minimized.
