Window will have to have a new wooden frame, which we supply. (It is double hung at present. ~~We also supply ventilators.~~)

We sent photographs of various St. Francis windows with the birds and the wolf of Gubbio. "I think the lower medallion of St. Francis in the window in St. George's Church, Maplewood or the one in the Church of the Holy Spirit, Lake Forest, are especially significant in relation to the window under consideration, for the surrounding ornamental pattern would help to harmonize it with the others now in place.

This window to have the figure of Saint Francis. See book which Mrs. Leonard left, "Les Petites Fleurs de Saint Francois D'Assise, Traduites Par Andr Perate, Illustrations de Maurice Denis Librairie de L'Art Catholique, 6 Place Saint Sulpice, Paris VI. (This to be returned). Would like a little suggestion of running brook, cypress, possibly a suggestion of a tree in the background, birds, flowers in the foreground, with touches of violet ^{and orange} in the flowers.

St. Francis in a brown robe, not as broken in color as the one in St. George's, Roxburg, without the violet. But she likes the face of this Roseburg Saint Francis best. Smallish gold halo.

Use border something like other aisle windows, with possibly a suggestion of grisaille background, to harmonize with the other windows.

Note: The Pastor said the chancel window needs repairing - cementing.
