General Information Saint Andrew.

As planned, this first panel of the window for the position nearest the chancel introduces the Beatitudes with "Blessed are the Poor in Spirit, for their's is the Kingdom of Heaven," represented by Saint Andrew, with his traditional diagonal cross, and the incident of the loaves and fishes below, when S. Andrew brought the boy to Christ with his meager supply of food from which the multitude was fed.

Symbol at the top represent the Dove for the Poor in Spirit.
