...We are sending now the Saint Christopher sketch, which I think will make a very lovely window.

The dominant figure is the traditional representation as he carries the Christ Child across the stream. The predella suggests the lovely legend of how Saint Christopher came to be a follower of Christ. As he journeyed with the devil, coming to a wayside cross, Satan went out of his way to avoid it, thereby bringing Christopher to the realization that there was a greater and more powerful master than the evil one whom he should seek. This, of course, lead to the river crossing."
