General Information To be designed in lovely and colorful pattern, featuring well-known Christian symbols, such as the Lamb of God, the Descending Dove of the Holy Spirit, the globe surmounted by the cross, or the anchor cross of Hope.

The tracings show pretty deep cusps that will have to be taken into careful account in the designs.

The Choir Windows

The choir windows are designed in foliated pattern and simple Christian symbols.

In the typical sketch, the Lamb of God bearing the Cruciform banner of Victory is represented in the upper member, while below are the globe surmounted by the cross, symbol of Our Lord's victory over the world, and the anchor cross of Hope.

In the opposite window, the descending Dove of the Holy Spirit might well be designed as the dominant symbol, and the IP and IHC monograms of Our Lord in the lower positions.

For the opposite choir window, we have designed the Descending Dove of the Holy Spirit in the upper position, with the well-known monograms of Our Lord, - the Chi Rho and the IHC, in the two lower positions.
