Subject: Abraham - Isaac.

Floor plan on black book sheet 2936. See photographs and Kodachromes of windows in place.

Figure of Abraham, the Patriarch, with young Isaac in front or somewhat to one side of him, as though on their way to the mountain, possibly carrying the Brazier of Fire and the Sacrificial Knife.

For symbols - The Ram in Thicket The Restraining Angel The Crude Altar.

We have completed the color sketches for both the Abraham and the Resurrection Windows, and are sending them to you herewith.

As planned, the first represents the Patriarch, Abraham, with the young Isaac on their way to the mountain. Abraham carries the brazier of fire and the sacrificial knife, while Isaac has a bundle of faggots.

Above is the restraining angel, and below is the ram caught in the thicket. Abraham's crude altar is also symbolized.

Dean Eldridge's criticism of design: "The oval surrounding the large medallion is indistinct and should be BLUE, DEFINITELY BLUE." We are to be sure to have the blue definitely lovely pure blue, as in the other windows of this color scheme.
