Subject: The Good Shepherd theme, in the nature of Pontiac, First Pres, or Boulder. To conform to other accepted windows.

As planned, it represents Christ the Good Shepherd. Holding the shepherd's crook and a lamb in His arms, He leads and guards His flock.

In the field below is the pelican feeding its young, traditional symbol of Our Lord's loving care and sacrifice, and the Chi Rho monogram of Christ.

The canopy around the central panel harmonizes with that in the other windows.

Across the base is the memorial inscription, "In memory of Mary I. B. Southworth".
