General Information Church is English Gothic design, with the usual square tower

First panel, angel. Central window, Christ blessing little children. Third panel, angel. Each of the angels would face the central window.

This group should probably be kept quite light, especially in the side panels.

Perhaps ask The Furman Leaded and Stained Glass Company in Birmingham to install.

Our suggestion for the children's choir windows is kept quite light to admit an abundance of illumination. At the center is Christ with a group of little children, - blessing them. Attendant angels at either side bear the text from St. Luke, - "Suffer little children to come unto Me".

Foliated pattern enriches the fields in the character of "grisaille", and white fleur-de-lis in the lower part of the central pattern suggest the purity of childhood.

Note: we are going to retain the horizontal division bars which are now in place.
