General Information This window is devoted to the Parables of the Sower (Mark 4:3); and The Talents (Matthew 25:14), with the lamps of the Wise and Foolish Virgins (Matthew 25:1) represented above.

June 3, 1953, Dr. Schloerb wrote: "...everyone is agreed that they like the warmer colors for the rose (above). Among suggestions was the one that they felt they would like more jeweled colors or more radiant colors than appear in the sketch. Probably the glass will be more heightened in its color effect than appears in opaque paint." (See photographs of windows in place.)
