General Information Dr. Marbach writes: "a study of Cherubims on the upper portion of the main panels would be a suggestion worth experimenting with. Once again have the artist bear in mind the limitation of external light and the limiting of intensive dark glass."

To be kept very simple design with maximum amount of light. To complement and enhance the lower windows, continuing upward the general character of the pattern of the field below, but keeping it as simple and direct as possible - as in the earlier sketches.

The Cherubs Window

We are sending you the color sketch for the balcony window, above the Children's window.

As suggested, the medallions in the heads of the lancets are devoted to cherubim,--ruby winged, the traditional symbol of Divine Love, in a blue field at the center and blue winged; the symbol of heavenly contemplation, in ruby fields at either side.
