General Information

This window is to have the symbols of The Lily, The Rose, and The Thorn Blossom (Glastonbury thorn).

It goes above The Good Samaritan Window. We are to keep in mind the texture and density of this east side, and be sure it has the same value as the lower window. There is to be a difference of treatment for the east and west windows - the west side has decidedly less outside light - the east side has an abundance of light.

We have made a color sketch showing how nicely the three floral symbols will work out in the upper east window....Will there be an inscription, etc.
