General Information RED MEDALLION BACKGROUND.
MINIMIZE THE HALO AS MUCH AS POSSIBLE, AND PUT SANDALS ON CHRIST'S FEET
HAVE BLUE ROBE WITH WHITE UNDERGARMENT. SEE ILLUSTRATION SHE SENT WHICH
SHE LIKES VERY MUCH - make sketch as near like this as possible.

Bottom - Calling the Apostles
Top - The Sermon on the Mount.

Donor writes: I like the Sermon on the Mount, but do not like so many
figures. (Have fewer figures, thus accenting Our Lord; also in the Calling
of the Apostles, have Our Lord take a very prominent position. "would
suit me if the Christ is made the predominant figure". SEE COLOR CARD THE
DONOR SENT WHICH SHE LIKES VERY MUCH. We said "Of course the colors must
be related to their surroundings, but you can be sure that red and blue will
be the principal colors."

We have strengthened both the ruby background and the blue of the Christ figures, and we are keeping in mind your love of pure rich reds and blues. You can be sure that we shall use an abundance of them in your window.

As in all the other windows of this group, the subjects read upward.

The lower medallion represents Our Lord as He called the disciples Peter and Andrew from their nets to be fishers of men. He stands on the shore and beckons to them in the boat. (We shall remember to give the water less prominence.)

The upper medallion symbolizes the Sermon on the Mount. Our Lord is seated and earnestly talking to a group of attentive listeners.

The foliated field around the medallions is designed to harmonize with the neighboring windows.
