General Information ~~In the left panel is the Crucifixion with Mary the Mother and John the Evangelist, and at the right, Christ appearing to Mary Magdalen. The backgrounds are enriched in a conventionalized grape pattern growing up through the center and outlining the subject medallions. We have a nice balance of pure rich color with enough silver and gold to insure a lovely brilliance and to avoid any suggestion of heaviness.~~

~~Left panel: The Crucifixion, Christ on the Cross, with two figures (probably the two Marys. Right panel, The Resurrection, showing Mary and the Risen Christ at the Tomb.~~
