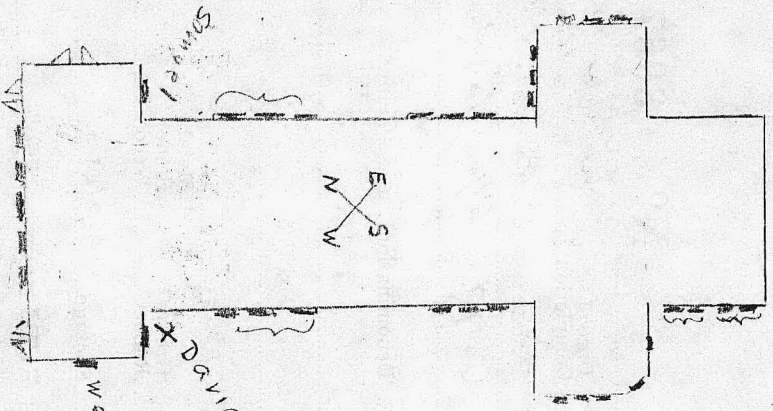

Represent David as the young shepherd and sweet singer of Israel.

We are getting the color sketch for the south vestibule under way. As planned, it is devoted to the young David, shepherd and great slayer of Israel, prototype of Our Lord.

We hold the key with which he opened King Saul. Saul is the first from Father 100:2 - born before his presence with singing, as well as a space for a possible mural inscription.
