General Information Symbolize Noah's Ark and the Barque of Saint Peter. Design these something in the nature of those in Chestertown.

This window is set in the metal frame with putty on the outside, like an ordinary window pane in a wooden sash. See letter of June 18, 1955, and exact measurements on accompanying sheet.

We have studied the design of your vestibule window and are sending you the rough color sketch herewith.

As planned, we have symbolized the Old and New Testaments in the traditional manner by representing Noah's Ark and Peter's Barque. The Dove with the Olive Branch hovers over the Ark, while the sail of the ship below is inscribed with the Cross of Faith. The surrounding field is enriched with light foliated pattern, and in fact it is our thought to keep the entire window in light brilliant tones to adequately illuminate the vestibule, but with accents of pure ruby and blue.
