The windows on the north side - third and fourth from the chancel are
about 6 feet from the ground. 1/2" rebate set in putty from outside.

This window symbolizes the Third Beatitude, "Blessed are the Meek, for they shall inherit the Earth", inscribed on the open book in the lower part of the central panel.

The dominant medallion above symbolizes Our Lord performing a Miracle of Healing.

As in the other windows, the angel figures at either side bear symbols of the Works of Mercy. At the left is the open book - "to Instruct the Ignorant"; and, at the right, the lamp, "to Counsel the Doubtful."

The memorial inscription is inscribed at the base -
"To the Glory of God and in Loving Memory of Francis Shaw, Jr."
