General Information Saint Ethelburga and Saint Frideswide.

Saint Ethelburga wears the queen's crown as King Edwin's queen, and holds the abbess' staff. In the principal medallion she lays the cornerstone of the Monastery which she built at Lyming. The upper star recalls the phrase that she shone as a star in a heathen court. The shells suggest the throngs she baptized, while the angel with the cross symbolizes another... descriptive phrase written of her, "She went as an obedient angel to plant the Blessed Rood." At the bottom is the significant text from the second chapter of Revelation, "Be thou faithful, and I will give you the crown of life."

Near Saint Frideswide is the symbol of the Ox, as in the arms of Oxford. The principal medallion represents her praying for the restoration of her pursuer's sight who God had blinded, while the small medallions symbolize her flight from Alfgar in the boat propelled by the Angel of God, and her miraculous healing of the Leper. In the head of the lancet is the symbol of the miraculous fountain near the site of her chapel, and in the base, the text, "Signs and wonders may be done by the name of... Jesus", (Acts 4:30).
