General Information "Saint Lydia."

...Staging for previous window arranged by Mr. Hellebush - by Mr. A. Archbold of Stewart and Bennett, Inc., 124-132 North Water Street, Rochester - a member of the firm belongs to the church. They also furnished a helper for Jim.

See O.E.S. note of Sept. 28, 1953, in folder about corrected templates of aisle windows, and notes about present windows.

In the center panel stands Saint Lydia holding a pitcher and glass to symbolize hospitality. The left panel represents the conversion of Saint Lydia "And Lydia heard us; whose heart the Lord opened" Acts 16: - 14. Below is a parallel from the Old Testament where the people of Baal are converted by Elijah, 1 Kings 18-39. The right panel depicts the hospitality of Lydia. "Saint Paul and Saint Silas and Saint Timothy enter the house of Saint Lydia". Below in the quarry field is a figure of Abraham entertaining angels. Genesis 18, 18. In the center panel below the feet of Saint Lydia is a little figure closing a door and motioning an intruder away to symbolize inhospitality. The cities represented above are Philippi, where Saint Lydia dwelt; Joppa; Achaea; Cilicia; Ptolemais; and ~~Phoenicia~~ *Phenice*.
