Color design for clerestory group devoted to the Disciples, - the third window from the chancel on the south side, and following Dr. Trexler's directions...

According to the plan, the group is devoted to Saint Thomas, Saint John, Saint Matthew and Saint Andrew.

Each holds his traditional symbols, -Saint Thomas, the spear and carpenter's square, recalling his martyrdom and his prowess as the heavenly palace builder for King Gudnaphar; Saint John with Chalice containing the serpent or dragon, recalling the poisoned cup from which he drank without harm; Saint Matthew's purse of coins as tax collector; and Saint Andrew with his diagonal cross.
