General Information This is to be the geometric and foliated design using the symbol of the Barque of Peter in the top medallion - the text, "Blessed are the Peacemakers, for they shall be called the children of God."

We have completed our study of the design for the Morse Memorial Window, and are sending you the color sketch herewith.

As planned, it is designed in the geometric and foliated pattern to harmonize with the others, and the traditional symbol of the Seraph of Peter with nail inscribed with the Cross, dominates the upper portion; with the accompanying text from the Beatitudes, "Blessed are the Peacemakers, for they shall be called the children of God."

In the base is the memorial inscription, "In loving memory of - George Stevenson Morse - 1860-1932 - Estella Hughes Morse - 1865-1937."

The lovely detail of design is only roughly suggested in this small scale rendering, which is intended to be an impression of color and light in action; but it will be carried out in the actual glass in a manner to harmonize with the rest of the windows.
