We have completed our study of the design for the Saint Luke window and are sending you the color sketch, herewith.

As planned, Saint Luke is represented at the center with the traditional book and pen of the Evangelist. His evangelistic symbol,--the winged ox, is suggested at one side in the blue field.

At the left, the Beloved physician is ministering to the ill, and at the right, Saint Paul baptizes Lydia.

We have suggested the citation from Saint Luke 12:32, "Fear not, for it is your Father's pleasure to give you the Kingdom", but if you prefer another text, it can of course be used just as well.
