General Information Saint James and Saint John.

The sketch for the second window from the entrance symbolizes Saint James Major and Saint John the Evangelist. Again each holds his significant symbols - the pilgrim's staff and gourd, and the book inscribed with the shell, for Saint James; and the pen and book inscribed with the chalice and serpent for Saint John the Evangelist.

The color scheme is planned to alternate ruby and blue, in the established manner.
