RED MEDALLION BSCKGROUND.

South aisle window - As planned, it is devoted to the Temptation in the Wilderness (Matthew 4:1-11) and (above) the Healing of the Nobleman's Son (John 4:46-54). Below, Satan tempts Our Lord with the crown of all the kingdoms of the world; while above, the Nobleman entreats Our Lord to heal his son. In the little insert between them the Nobleman's son is symbolized at home in bed.

The field is enriched with ornamental patterning similar to that in the other windows

The medallion backgrounds and borders are in ruby, carrying out the alternating plan of color, the one next to it having blue in these areas.
