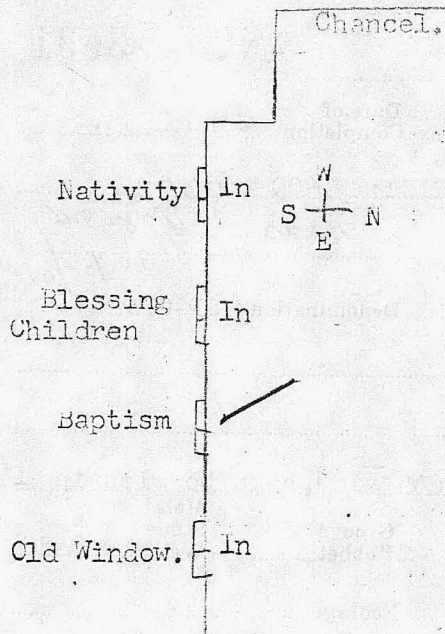

Saint John the Baptist, with his rustic crossed staff, and shall, is represented at the left, with Our Lord standing in the Jordan at the right, and the Dove of the Holy Spirit shedding rays of Divine Grace upon Him.

It is planned to harmonize with the two earlier windows, with small angelic figures of praise and prayer, with censer and trumpet, in the heads of each lancet; and another bearing a scroll in the tracery member. The scroll would bear a significant text, ~~which~~ "This is my Beloved Son", ~~as you prefer.~~

The flowering border is in keeping with that in the window devoted to the Nativity, suggesting the rose of Divine Love.
