The fourth and last window is devoted to Moses, who bears the Tablets of
the Commandments with the brazen serpent raised on the staff as the symbol
below. At the left he kneels before the vision of God in the Burning Bush;
and, at the right, he receives the Commandments on Mount Sinai. The
alternating color scheme of ruby and blue medallions and figures is
carried through this group in pleasant harmony of contrast.
