...new tracery openings for the south transept window...Just for comparison, we have mounted the design for one of the Butler windows under it. We have suggested symbols of the Old Testament, - the Ark of the Covenant, and the seven-branched candlestick in the two central quatrefoils.

In the outer left one we have indicated Peter's Barque, with the Cross inscribed on the sails; and the ~~new symbol of the World Council of Churches~~ in the opposite position. I think it might be better to reverse these with the Old Testament symbols in the outer position or, of course they could be changed to any symbols you prefer...

symbol of the chalice and bread

Criticism of Architect of sketch: "Mrs. Howe and I both feel that the design of the two angels above St. Peter, is somewhat more minute in scale than the other symbols and may not carry as well as the ship, the candelabrum and the chalice, since the distance above the floor is seventeen feet."
