General Information To be devoted to The Last Supper, ~~from the Annals~~

Side Sanctuary Window:

This window is devoted to the Last Supper. Our Lord holding the chalice sits at the head of the table with the Apostles grouped around Him. Saint John is distinguished by the bright ruby garment approaching in purity the red of Our Lord's cloak, Saint Peter is robed in green, Judas wears a dull brown. He is sometimes represented in a dull olive green, but the warmer color seemed more appropriate in the composition. However, it could be changed if you prefer.

In the light silvery field below, outlined by the growing vine pattern in harmony with the aisle windows, are significant symbols, - the sacred monogram IHS, and the ~~pelican feeding its young with its life blood.~~ Monstrance.

The narrower foliated border will also echo the aisle windows.

Across the base is the text, - ~~"This is my blood... shed for... remission of sins"~~. "Do this in commemoration of me".

The white field and tablecloth will admit an abundance of illumination.
