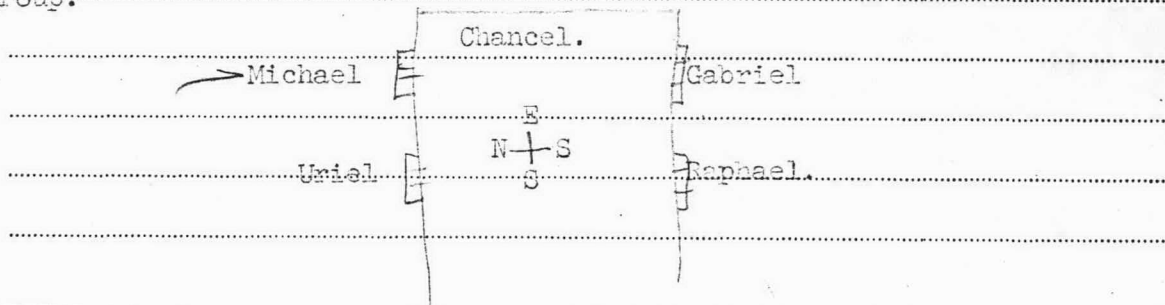
Make typical design - St. Michael, Archangel.

General Information We are to use the Four Major Archangels: that is, one as the central figure in each of the four 3-lancet groups, which are just the same size and continue the nave clerestory group.

It should be somewhat lighter than the nave clerestories, but the same general plan; that is, Archangel at the center, with symbols either side. The symbols might be lower down in the lancet than in the other clerestory windows.

(Dr. Higgins plans to use the present windows in another place. They now have symbols of the twelve Apostles.)

These choir windows are just the same size and continue the nave clerestory group.



Design for a typical choir clerestory window...it is devoted to the Archangel, Saint Michael, Captain of the Hosts of Heaven. He is represented at the center in armor and surcoat slaying the dragon. At the left is the cross and scales, and at the right is his flaming sword.

The window is designed to harmonize with those in the nave clerestory, but in an even more brilliant palette.

The plan would be to complete the group with the remaining three major archangels, - Saints Gabriel, Uriel and Raphael.
