To contain small figures of Old Testament prophets - Isaiah, Jeremiah,  
and Moses.

12/31/56 from Architect Suter: "It has been decided to make the sash stationary -  
they have not been opened for years anyway - and to rebuild the bottoms, thereby  
gaining around 2' in the height of the openings. The daylight measurements of  
the principal opening in each will be 10 1/4" wide as previously, by 27" high."  
Feb. 18, 1957. Let Mr. Suter know when windows will be ready, so that he can have  
the bottom rails changed before the new glass is installed.

We have now completed the color sketch for the tower vestibule window, and are sending it to you herewith.

As suggested, it is devoted to the Old Testament Prophets, Isaiah, Jeremiah and Moses.

At the left Isaiah holds the tongs and coal of fire, with which the angel cleansed his lips.

Jeremiah is represented with the chains of bondage; and Moses, the Tablets of the Law.

Across the base is the memorial inscription.

We have the change in the text which you gave us on October twenty-fourth, - "To the Glory of God, Mr. and Mrs. Vernon A. Forsberg". We find this very difficult to compose in the three panels, and you can readily see that the first form "To the Glory of God, Virginia Forsberg - Vernon Forsberg", divides much better.

We could use the preferred version by having it in quite small letters in two lines at the base of the central panel, but the figures would have to be shortened a bit to do this, and we wanted to keep them as large as possible. We should be glad to have your suggestions for the solution of this problem.
