General Information We have a panel of glass that Mr. Roberts gave Mr. Appleton, that he wants to have put in the new Parish House, on the stair-landing. Can be reached from a step ladder on the inside. The panel measures 33 3/8 x 39 7/8. The opening is 33 3/8 x 46 1/8, full size. There is a half inch stop bead on the top and sides, and 7/8 rebate at the bottom. The height will be 1 3/8" less than 46 1/8", or 44 3/4". Width sight 1/2" less - 32 3/8. That means we have a little over 4 inches at the bottom for a memorial inscription which is to read:

"To the Glory of God and in loving memory of (on one line) 1847 William and Nellie K. Appleton 1852 (on the other line) 1942 1945

PUT INSCRIPTION UP AS FAR AS POSSIBLE ON ACCOUNT OF SILL. We are supposed to provide protection glass - suggested rough plate. They expect to have the place finished up in a month or two - about June 7 or July 7, and would like to have the window as soon as possible, although there is no definite date.

There should be new reinforcing bars provided.
