General Information To be devoted to Saint Olaf of Norway

Refer to other windows - windows to be bright and colorful, as building is dark.

We have completed our study of the window to be devoted to Saint Olaf, Patron of Norway, and are sending you the color sketch herewith.

He is represented as king and warrior, with the crown and sword, and he holds aloft the symbol of the orb surmounted by the cross in token of his zealous chieftainship of the propagation of Christianity.

We have suggested the alternate ^{Red} ~~blue~~ background, assuming that he is not to be the companion to Saint George; but ~~if~~ he is to be placed in the opening beside Saint George, ~~we should~~ change the border to ruby, and ~~probably~~ introduce a little more pure reds in his cloak.

Of course this can very easily be taken care of in the selection of the actual glass.

Important - this panel is to be a companion to the St. George panel, so the color scheme will have to be changed to conform to this. That is, the border is to be ruby instead of blue, and a little more red is to be put into his cloak.
