Floor plan on #4096. The plan is to eventually lengthen the nave, and include the list of subjects given us previously. At present there is only one pair of nave windows on each side.

Be sure to have the windows blue, as in previous sketch.

As planned, it is devoted to themes from the life of Our Lord beginning with Christ Blessing Little Children (lower left medallion), the Triumphal Entry into Jerusalem and the Cleansing of the Temple. In the same order the right panel represents, - The Widow's Mite, the Last Supper, and Our Lord in Gethsemane.

I suspect that we have not indicated as much blue in this sketch as we did in the last. Not having the earlier one at hand, variations are quite likely, but I can assure you that the actual window will be carried out in the same palette as the first, with a predominance of blue.
