General Information Saint Andrew, with symbolism, very much like that in the Highland Park aisle window.

This window to conform in scale and treatment to other windows in place.

Recently, we read of your call to St. George's Church, Newport, and we have put forward the color sketch for the Foulkes memorial window, so that plans for its development may be completed before you leave Winthrop.

As planned, Saint Andrew is represented as a man of strong character standing by the seaside and holding his symbols, the oar and the net. His boat is on the waters and near by is a seagull. The shield in the border is inscribed with the diagonal cross identifying him as the patron of Scotland and the fisher of men.

Across the base is the memorial inscription,-  
"In Memory of Thomas A. and Ida M. Foulkes."
