"...Above Our Lord are the symbolic Alpha and Omega, symbolizing the beginning and the end; and, at the top, His familiar monograms, the IHC and Chi Rho.

Twelve sheep are designed in other tracery members, symbolizing the Twelve Apostles going out into the world to preach the Gospel, looking back to Our Lord for their inspiration.

Stars of heavenly steadfastness are designed in the smaller tracery members.
