General Information To be devoted to The Healing Christ, similar to the one in St. Luke's Church, Denver.

(This will be a companion of the Boy Christ in the Temple.)

See photographs of other windows in place.

*Note: The Boy Christ in the Temple, which is the companion panel to this window was placed in the left-hand panel. When this panel is placed, they will move the lower part of the left panel to the right panel, putting the new panel with the angel in the left panel, so that the angels will face each other. So, make this new window just as it is designed, with the above arrangement in mind.

As planned, it is devoted to the Healing Christ composed in much the same manner as the one you liked in the Denver church.

Our Lord is shown ministering to the crippled and blind. Above is the cross potent or cross of healing, and below is the CHI RHO monogram of Our Lord. The border and field is planned to harmonize with the companion window.

The kneeling Angel of Prayer may be facing whichever way you prefer.

Note: We shall make the window as designed. When the new panel is completed, they will move the lower part of the companion window to the right opening, and put new lower panel with the Boy Christ in the Temple.

NOTE: MRS. MANCHESTER WRITES: "...the red stained glass in Mrs. Pittinger's window is much deeper than the Alway windows. The latter is a more orange-red." (See color plates for the shade of red.) BE SURE TO KEEP THE DEEPER RUBIES IN THIS NEW WINDOW FOR BEST HARMONY WITH ITS COMPANION. 5/18/59.
