General Information Four other windows on this same level have symbols of 8 or the 12 tribes: We are to complete these two with the remaining four tribes - two in each window:

- Simeon (a sword),
- Dan (an adder)
- Asher (a horn of plenty)
- Benjamin (a wolf).

Rough color sketches -

The two principal ones devoted to the Tribes of Israel bear symbols of the remaining four Tribes, - the horn of plenty for Asher, the wolf for Benjamin, the sword for Simeon, and the adder for Dan. Our thought is to develop them in harmony with the present windows, at a cost of eight hundred and fifty dollars each; that is, seventeen hundred dollars for both, including their installation.
