General Information Suggested symbols of the four Evangelists in upper tier, and symbols of the four Major Prophets who supported them on the tier below.

These should be designed in one piece of glass and carried out in one color, blue or red each by etching, and the addition of gold stain, at a cost of not more than one hundred dollars each.

These can easily be inserted in the present lead; ~~or they could be leaded with a little more freedom of color and design for \$125 to \$150 dollars, inserted in the same manner.~~

~~Or, effects more like those in St. James Church, Dabbury, and the Denver Cathedral Sacristy windows would involve the removal of the present windows to cut in and relead around the medallion. This would involve considerably more cost.~~

(At present these windows are filled with ^{light tinted} American Antique glass with a small blue glass border around each window.)

*Father Bruce says "...exact size of the panels...6 inches wide by 12 inches high. The daylight opening is 6 x 12", and the width of the lead is 3/4" wide..."
