General Information Subject: The Jesse Tree (A distinguished Jesse Tree).

(See letter of September 22, 1958, for suggestions as to subjects for
other windows in the Chapel.

Note: The upper mullions are to be taken out, so that they are just
three long panels. Also the window has been raised about 6 inches
from that shown on the original print, to clear the pews.

We feel the theme of the Jesse Tree has worked out beautifully in the three lancets and tracery.

At the base of the central lancet is the reclining figure of Jesse from whom issues the branches of the conventionalized Tree framing and supporting the figures of the Kings of Judah, - first, David with his harp, and then four others in the outer panels. ~~These are unnamed, although if you prefer, we could designate definite ones in the lineage of Our Lord.~~

The Blessed Virgin Mary is shown in a rose like shape above David and below the radiant figure of Our Lord.

Attendant Angels of Praise and Prayer with trumpet and censer complete the heads of the side lancets, while the seven nimbed Doves, symbols of the seven Gifts of the Holy Spirit enrich the tracery.

Following tradition, I think it is well to include Prophets, - Our Lord's spiritual ancestors, - one at either side of Jesse.

I think the Chapel devoted to the Old Testament will be very lovely and a most significant addition to the effectiveness of your Church.
