General Information

This window to be devoted to Saint Matthew with related incidents. This window goes next to the Saint Luke window - see photograph. Also see photograph of the Saint John Evangelist window on north side. This design to be carried out in the exact same manner as the earlier ones.

Note that this window and the one on the other side of the Saint Luke window will have the red border and background scheme - with the blue-winged cherubim, - like the Saint John window on the other side - see sketch of this.

Saint Matthew holds the halberd, instrument of his martyrdom.

The dominant medallion represents his call from the receipt of customs; and in the lower one, Saint Matthew preaches in Egypt.

In the intermediate medallion he baptizes Iphigenia, daughter of the King of Ethopia where he was missionary.

At the top, he is represented writing his Gospel.
