*This was an anonymous gift... "There is to be no acknowledgment or memorial in the window or on a plate. If practical, please arrange that the art glass include in a lower corner the letters, P.G.S., not more than 1/2 inch in height, and diffused into the colors so that they are not apparent, except upon careful examination at close range."

(The companion window not yet ordered.) These are the two little windows immediately at either side of the entrance porch; that is, at either side of the lunette over the door.

This window (and the companion to be made at some later time) are devoted to welcoming Angels of Praise and Prayer - this one to Prayer, with censer. The palette is kept light to admit an abundance of illumination and to harmonize with the panels over the door, but well accented with generous passages of pure, rich color.
