General Information Symbolic design - ~~Small~~ ~~Dove hovering over a fountain~~ of Saint David of Wales - The Dove as the principal symbol, the Fountain as secondary.

As planned, the principal symbol for Saint David is the dove. It is represented above the symbol of the fountain springing up and forming the decorative pattern.
