To have simple theme of the lighter side of Christian fellowship, as they are passed when entering and leaving the social and dining room of our church.

We suggested colorful figures of the young David with the harp, and Miriam with her timbrel, as accents in quite simple light fields. *see later other side*

Architect writes: "These windows can be readily seen as people enter our entrance."

Minister writes: "...the lower pair of windows at the left of the entrance...
Mary and Martha. People see this window as they come down the steps from church.
These two women tell of two phases that all ~~of~~/~~live~~ of our lives should have -
sitting at the feet of Christ and serving. This would also be appropriate thinking
of the window in its position of entrance to our dining and social hall.
Women serve in the kitchen and people gathering in Logan Hall often get
spiritual as well as physical food..."

"The window near the entrance is devoted to Martha and Mary, - the two types ^{of}
Christian womanhood, active service and devoted prayer and worship. Martha
holds a basket of fruit, while Mary holds the book of worship.

Bethany, while Mary is shown in prayer at the feet of Jesus.,.,,"
