General Information To be designed in the manner of the Rose in the State Street, Congregational Church, Portland, Maine, using the symbols of the seven Sacraments in seven of the petals; with the symbol of the Holy Spirit (Dove) in the eighth, at the top. In the center design an orb and cross or a Chi-Rho symbol of Our Lord who instituted the Sacraments.....

The Church building will be traditional Gothic design.

Below the window and above the altar will be a large Christ the King Crucifix.

As planned, we have represented the orb surmounted by the cross, symbol of Our Lord's triumph over the world, at the center; the symbol of the Descending Dove of the Holy Spirit, at the top; and symbols of the Sacraments in the remaining petals.

Baptism is symbolized by the shell; the chalice and Host for Holy Eucharist; the keys of heaven for Penance; the ~~Bible~~ Bible for Ordination; the olive, Holy Unction; and the entwined rings for Matrimony. The Descending Dove is often used as a symbol of Confirmation, but in this case we have used the flame of Divine Inspiration.

Bishop's Mitre

We have slightly emphasized the cross by a counterchange of border and background colors, ruby and blue, introducing a pleasant variation without disturbing the over-all harmony.

Changes in design: Changed symbol of Bible to Bishop's Mitre for Ordination - to give the ancient teaching of Apostolic Succession in Holy Orders.

As the window receives a full unobstructed south light, even in full color it should be well controlled with textures.
