General Information. Make designs for two doorlights - interior doors - plate glass. They are roughly 2 feet wide by 6 feet high - about 1 foot from floor.

The lower 2 feet to be clear on account of the Holy Water Stoup to be fastened and covering the door a bit at that point. The design to be sand-blasted.

Both designs to be devoted to The Trinity and the Church, as outlined in the tracing paper drawings given us by Mr. Kennedy.

Near the bottom of the right design are the Seven Sacraments on Seven Shields, symbolized as outlined below on the tracing.

In the opposite window, the Seven Gifts, symbolized by seven flames in the same manner. the design at the right, the three Trinity Circles are interlaced, with small crosses, and the Ship of the Church has a cross on the sail.
