General Information "This window is the same size as the ones in the west entrance, which you are now furnishing."

Window

This/~~these~~ to carry on the theme established in the west entrance windows.

To be devoted to the Deacons, Stephen and Philip, to symbolize COURAGE AND KINDNESS: (virtues) (Courage symbolized by the Lion for St. Stephen; and Kindness symbolized by a basket of bread for Saint Philip.)

*Red borders*

*Deacons - palm & stones  
Philip = Patriarchal Cross  
Spears*

One of these is for the window in the east entrance-way, and is devoted to the Deacons, Saint Stephen and Saint Phillip. This pair has red borders, and Stephen has his usual symbols, the stones of his martyrdom, and holds the martyrs' palm. The symbol below him is the Lion for the Virtue Courage; Phillip has the patriarchal cross and spear; and the Virtue below him is Kindness, symbolized by a basket of bread.
