General Information The two panels ordered is the Wise and Foolish Builders, and the New Patch on old Garments. Inasmuch as the partial section to the left of the Wise and Foolish Builders is part of that theme, we have agreed to include it without additional cost.

*This price is \$60 for the Wise and Foolish Builders (Matthew 7:24) - True and False Reception of the Gospel; and \$45 for The New Patch on Old Garments (Matthew 9:16) - New Doctrine and Ancient Prejudice; plus \$45 for installation - perhaps when someone is in that direction.

(Both of these are in the third tier from the bottom)

Note: original color sketch cannot be found, but we have color notes and black and white print of the design. We already have in the place, The Lost Sheep, The Rich Man and the Beggar, and the Wise and Foolish Virgins.

The Wise and Foolish Builders - these two panels are now both white Cathedrals, so we can paint the portion of white Cathedral in a gold stain. The standing figure to be blue, with a blue background. The panel devoted to the Patch, is to be a red field, and it could be a greeny-white figure.

All of the lower panels in the casement sections are 5 3/8" wide. The lower tier

and the upper tier of the panels in the casement section are 9 inches high. ~~Three~~
The three intermediate tiers are $9 \frac{1}{8}$ " high, all sight. Sca~~n~~t $\frac{1}{2}$ " lead.

The lower tier of the sections above the casements is 9" high. The middle
panel $5 \frac{3}{8}$ " wide, and the outer panels without the border, $5 \frac{3}{4}$ " wide.
The window is all in Cathedrals - very light green, amber, blue and white.
